2022 In Review: Country Looks To The **Future With One Eye On The Past**



From its very infancy, one of the attractions of country music has been its respect for the past.

Many of the genre's early pioneers, including Jimmie Rodgers and The Carter Family, made their mark by leaning on so-called "old-fashioned songs," nostalgic material drawn from a simpler

time, before the mass migration to the city, before the Model T destroyed the horse and buggy, and before racy, decadent jazz had reached its peak.

Of course, music is an art, and artists tend to experiment, so the ongoing major battle in country music is the push and pull between expanding boundaries

and hanging on to tradition.


Appropriately in 2022 — which happened to mark the 100th anniversary of the first country recording session—that tug of war between progress and tradition was very much evident.

Musically, the sounds of the past were trendy as the current generation of hit-makers celebrates '90s country. The genre was full of examples, including three of the top 10 songs on the yearend Country Airplay chart: the Garth Brooks-like drama of Cody Johnson's "'Til You Can't," the heartbreak storyline filtered through a Texas troubadour in Scotty McCreery's "Damn Strait" and the Cole Swindell megahit "She Had Me at Heads

Carolina," which returned the melody of Jo Dee Messina's debut to regular rotation over two decades after its original chart run.

The rise of ronky tonk—a raw, stripped-down form of country (maybe it should be spelled "rawnky tonk"?) — pushed back against the genre's 10-year party mode while sounding a little

more like country has historically presented itself. It brought a new round of young artists to the forefront, including Bailey Zimmerman, Zach Bryan, Jackson Dean and Nate Smith. And it took place as the Paramount+ series Yellowstone soared, resurrecting the once popular western format



Yet even as country recycled its past, the format is clearly moving forward at the same time. The ubiquitous presence of Jimmie Allen, the multiple collaborations of BRELAND, Kane Brown's experiment with stadium headlining and the introduction of new talents — including Madeline Edwards, Tiera Kennedy, Brittany Spencer, The War and Treaty and **Chapel Hart**—underscores a very real interest in expanding the genre's diversity, with Black and biracial women making greater inroads alongside the recent uptick in the format's Black males.

Not that the progressive edge of country rosters and playlists is a one-issue concern. Frank Ray and Kat + Alex are bringing a long-absent Latino influence to the genre's mainstream, while other acts continue widening the sound of country, including Americana-leaning Boy Named Banjo, hip-hop-tinged Kidd G, adventurous Sam Williams and piano-based Ingrid Andress.

It's not just the artistic part of country that moved forward in 2022. Podcasts and streaming continued growing, opening more avenues for songs and artists to emerge. BBR Music Group even assigned dedicated employees to focus on single, sprawling media companies: YouTube manager Agron Wilder and vp of promotion and marketing/SiriusXM Radio Scotty O'Brien.

Country radio, historically the dominant platform for exposing new music, recognized its diminished role more openly. Several panels at February's Country Radio Seminar addressed broadcasters' sluggish approach to music rotations, and Country's Radio Coach owner **John Shomby** spearheaded a committee that united multiple industry factions in an attempt to reverse the trend.

CRS was held in person after the pandemic forced a remote version of the seminar in 2021. It wasn't the only annual event that returned to a physical location: CMA Fest took over Nashville's downtown again after a two-year absence, though a number of industry members caught COVID-19 during the celebration.

Nearly every artist was back on the road, too, creating its own set of issues. With some longtime support crew retiring or changing career paths during the pandemic, artists—particularly at the club and theater level—were challenged when trying to book full road teams and transportation.

The Academy of Country Music became the first major organization to shift its awards show from network TV to a streaming platform, and Viacom shifted the CMT Music Awards for the first time from cable to the CBS broadcast network, revising the schedule in the process as the CMTs moved from the week of CMA Fest to the spring.

By summer, the new routine left much of the industry's personnel worn out as they returned to a hyper-active calendar after two years of mostly working at home.

Reigning over it all was **Morgan Wallen**, whose *Dangerous: The Double Album* dynamited the previous chart record by extending his No. 1 status on Country Albums to 86 weeks. Despite not fully cleaning up his public image after uttering a racial slur in February 2020, he topped nine different country lists among *Billboard*'s year-end charts, snared a CMA nomination for entertainer of the year, had the RIAA certify 43 different titles during the calendar year and set a 2023 concert schedule that includes 17 stadiums.

The subject of race is part of the push and pull that the industry will continue to address in the future. Back when those old-fashioned songs first took hold in the 1920s, record executives specifically marketed hillbilly records and race music — as the categories were called at the time — to separate audiences. In short order, the artists were segregated as well. The industry is taking steps to better reach Black audiences and expand the ranks of African American executives. Progress is essential to keep every valuable enterprise alive. \bullet

Morgan Wallen First At Nos. 1, 2 & 3 On Hot Country Songs In Single Week, 'You Proof' Extends Country Airplay Command



Morgan Wallen makes history on *Billboard*'s streaming-, airplay- and salesbased Hot Country Songs chart (dated Dec. 17), becoming the first artist to simultaneously hold Nos. 1, 2 and 3 since the survey launched as an allencompassing genre ranking in 1958.

"You Proof" (Big Loud) hits 17 weeks atop the tally, tying **Thomas Rhett**'s "Die a Happy Man" (2015-16) for the 10th-longest reign. Just ahead is **Florida Georgia Line**'s "H.O.L.Y.," (18 weeks, 2016), while FGL and **Bebe Rexha**'s

crossover smash, "Meant To Be," dominated for a record 50 weeks in 2017-18.

"You Proof" corralled 28.3 million all-format airplay audience impressions and 12.6 million official U.S. streams, and sold 2,000 downloads Dec. 2-8, according to Luminate.

Plus, three of Wallen's songs debut on Hot Country Songs in the top 10 — "One Thing at a Time" (No. 2), "Tennessee Fan" (No. 5) and "Days That End in Why" (No. 7) — while his former 11-week No. 1, "Wasted On You," holds at No. 3, granting him his unprecedented triumph in the top three. The trio of new songs is slated to appear on Wallen's next album.

Wallen, who now has 17 total Hot Country Songs top 10s, thus owns five of the top 10 on the Dec. 17 chart — a feat

that only he has achieved. The record is six songs in the tier, set on the Jan. 23, 2021, chart when *Dangerous: The Double Album* began its 81-week-and-counting command on Top Country Albums. He also claimed half the Hot Country Songs top 10 the following two weeks.

On Country Digital Song Sales, "Thing," "Tennessee" and "Days" (all released Dec. 2) arrive at Nos. 1, 2 and 3 with 13,000, 12,000 and 10,000 sold through Dec. 8, respectively. Wallen is the second artist to take over the chart's top three with debut tracks, after **Taylor Swift** did so twice (in November 2010 and November 2011), and he ups his career count to eight No. 1s among 19 top 10s on the list.

Meanwhile, "You Proof" rebounds from No. 2 to rule Country Airplay for a seventh week (23.9 million, down 7%). It joins five other titles for the second-longest reign since the chart started in 1990. The record is eight,

held by Alan Jackson and Jimmy Buffett's "It's Five O'Clock Somewhere" (2003) and Lonestar's crossover ballad, "Amazed" (1999). "You Proof" now solely boasts the longest No. 1 stay of the 2020s, surpassing Dustin Lynch's "Thinking 'Bout You," featuring MacKenzie Porter (starting last December), and Luke Combs' "Forever After All" (starting in June 2021).

Additionally, "You Proof" is the first Country Airplay chart-topper to rebound to No. 1 after multiple songs reached the peak in between. After it

ruled for five weeks (Oct. 15-Nov. 12), **Tyler Hubbard**'s "5 Foot 9" topped the Nov. 19 chart, followed by **Thomas Rhett**'s "Half of Me," featuring **Riley Green** (Nov. 26), and — after "You Proof" led again on the Dec. 3 tally — **Bailey Zimmerman**'s "Fall in Love" (Dec. 10).

KANE & KATELYN CLIMB Kane Brown and Katelyn Brown's "Thank God" (Zone 4/RCA Nashville) hits the Country Airplay top 10 (12-10, 18.1 million, up 6%). Kane adds his 10th such hit, and his wife claims her first in her initial chart appearance.

FLIP TO FRIDAYS As previously noted in industry communications, *Billboard* is shifting the airplay chart tracking week to Friday-Thursday, from the current Monday-

Sunday used for all individual formats. (The all-format Radio Songs chart, which contributes to the Billboard Hot 100, already runs Friday-Thursday.)

The dates for making this change are now set: Charts finalized Monday, Dec. 19 (dated Dec. 24), will use data from Monday, Dec. 12 through Sunday, Dec. 18. Charts finalized Friday, Dec. 23 (dated Dec. 31), will use data from Friday, Dec. 16, through Thursday, Dec. 22.

The Friday-Thursday tracking week will continue for airplay charts finalized Friday, Dec. 30 (dated Jan. 7, 2023), using data from Friday, Dec. 23, through Thursday, Dec. 29, and each week thereafter.

Moving format charts to Friday-Thursday will align airplay with the streaming and sales tracking week, as well as allow for visible building chart tracking within Luminate's Music Connect platform, which operates under that song consumption timeline.

COUNTRY AIRPLAY CHART LEGEND

RANKINGS

Country Airplay is ranked by total audience impressions for the week ending Sunday based on monitored airplay by Mediabase of 145 stations by Luminate. Audience totals on the chart are derived, in part, using certain Nielsen Audio-copyrighted Persons 12+ audience estimates (under license © 2022, Nielsen Audio). The list of all Country Airplay chart reporters can be viewed in Luminate's online platform.

TIES

On Country Airplay, if two songs are tied in audience, the song with the larger increase in audience is placed first.

BULLETS

Awarded on Country Airplay to titles gaining audience or remaining flat from the previous week. A song will also receive a bullet if its percentage loss in audience does not exceed the percentage of monitored station downtime for the format. Titles that decline in audience but increase in detections will also receive a bullet if the total audience erosion for the week does not exceed 3%.

RECURRENTS

On Country Airplay, descending titles below No. 10 in either audience or detections are moved to recurrent after 20 weeks, provided that they are not still gaining enough audience points to bullet or if they rank below No. 10 and post a third consecutive week of (non-bulleted) audience decline, regardless of total chart weeks. Plus, songs that ascend to a peak between Nos. 1 and 5 will remain on the chart for one additional week even if dropping below No. 10.

HOT SHOT DEBUT

Awarded to the highest-ranking new entry on Country Airplay.

MOST INCREASED AUDIENCE

Most Increased Audience on Country Airplay lists the songs with the greatest week-to-week increases in total audience.

AIRPOWER

Awarded on Country Airplay to titles ranking inside top 20 in plays and audience rankings for the first time, with increases in both plays and audience.

BREAKER

Awarded on Country Airplay to titles achieving airplay (at least one detection) at 60% of reporting stations for the first time.










PETER COOPER REMEMBERED

The cluster of Nashville journalists who cover country music full time is a fairly small group, particularly when it's whittled down to those focused on music as an art form, or as a business, rather than as a celebrity beat.

Thus, the death of Peter Cooper on Dec. 6 hit Nashville's music community hard. Cooper died in his sleep from a severe head injury suffered in a fall. He was 52.

It has been said frequently that writing about music is like dancing about architecture - words fail to capture the solidity of a beat, the melancholy torture of a gorgeous melody or the crisp emotionalism that accompanies the match of a lyric to its musical accompaniment.

Cooper, hired by *The Tennessean* in 2000, proved more than capable of the task, bringing the understanding he gained as an independent artist to the role. He held tremendous empathy for the subjects he covered, including titans such as Johnny Cash, George Jones and Kris Kristofferson, who reportedly told Cooper that he looked "at the world with an artist's eye and a human heart and soul."

Ricky Skaggs told *Billboard* he considered Cooper "one of the most gentle and soft-spoken men I ever knew. His knowledge of music, the writers, the players and singers was really unmatched in Nashville. Our industry lost a vital voice for our times."

Cooper's voice, both as a writer and an audio storyteller, became a significant part of the Country Music Hall of Fame induction process in recent years as he contributed to the annual medallion ceremonies in his role as senior directorproducer-writer. He invariably brought extra dimension to even the most familiar biographies and musical legacies of new members via scripts and video packages.

Cooper will be honored with a memorial service in early 2023. In lieu of flowers, his family asks that donations be made to the Baker Cooper fund to support his 12-year-old son's education, care of Wells Fargo Bank, 1712 West End Ave., Nashville, TN 37203. -Additional reporting by Melinda Newman.



High Valley Packages Rootsy Holiday Reality With 'Back Home Christmas'

Given that **Brad Rempel**'s hometown of La Crete, Alberta, is closer to the North Pole than any other country artist's, **High Valley** is perhaps better qualified than any other act in the format to cut Christmas songs.

Although, truth be told, Rempel is hard-pressed to get overly sentimental about the holiday. He's not a Scrooge about it, but he's often underwhelmed by the music.

"It's always kind of a joke among my friends that, 'Well, you live up there near Santa Claus. You should love Christmas stuff,'" he says. "There's nowhere on Earth that feels more like Christmas than northern Canada. You can literally skate on frozen ponds and ride snowmobiles, you know, watch the snow fall-

ing down. I mean, everything about it is kind of your stereotypical Hallmark Christmas movie kind of vibes."

Rempel's resistance to holiday tracks may have played a role in making High Valley's new seasonal release, "Back Home Christmas," an engaging, and pandemically appropriate, piece for 2022. When he showed up at Full Circle Studio — the workplace of songwriter-producer Seth Mosley (for King & Country, Michael W. Smith) - on May 23, the assignment was to craft new yuletide material with Jon Nite ("Pick Me Up," "You Didn't") and Zach Kale ("I Hope," "The Good Ones"). And Rempel admitted up front that they would have to clear a rather high bar.

"I was like, 'Hey, full disclosure, guys: I'm not a huge fan of Christmas music,' "recalls Rempel with a laugh. "Jon and Zach were like, 'OK,' and then they pretend-like packed up their guitars and walked out of the room. And I was like, 'But I love a great Christmas

song. I just want to make sure this feels like a legitimate High Valley song and not just your token "Here Comes Santa Claus" type of deal.'"

As it turns out, Rempel was feeling disconnected from his roots as he considered Christmas. La Crete isn't easy to reach (flying from Nashville to Edmonton takes seven to 11 hours, and then it's a four-plus-hour drive north from there), and under COVID-19 circumstances, he hadn't been home since 2019. He felt a need to return for this year's holidays, and Mosley suggested they get in the spirit by writing something in 6/8 time.

"For me, 6/8 just always feels like Christmas," Mosley explains. "It automatically just puts you in a more nostalgic head frame."

Indeed, the holiday songs written in waltz-time signatures 6/8 and 3/4 — "Silver Bells," "The First Noel," "We Three Kings" and "Happy Xmas (War Is Over)," just to name a few — have a classic feel about them. Mosley developed a chord progression for that format, called up plug-in sounds of sleigh bells and church bells, and turned the lights down to mimic the feel of a Tennessee Christmas. And they found a musical style with an old-world vibe.

"I remember playing some Celtic-y stuff, kind of an Irish singalong—almost like a reverent drinking song or like a hymn," says Nite. "That helped change the direction of the sound."

Rempel's desire to get back to Canada for the holiday resonated throughout the room as they began to craft a story.

"I wanted to feel that feeling of going back home when you're just out of high school and you go to college, and you go back that first or second time," Nite says. "There's something magical about when you're 18 or 20 years old, you're coming back for the first time after leaving town. It's so amazing to come back home and be like, 'OK, this is a safe place that made me who I am. These people love me no matter what.'"

Even though the song was about returning somewhere, it took some work to nail down a hook that would serve as the song's destination.

"At one point, we were like, 'I'll be back on Christmas,' "remembers Kale. "'Back Home Christmas' seems to land that hook a lot better and makes you feel something—just the word 'home.' We started writing toward that."

The first lines of the chorus — "I miss those O holy silent nights/Popcorn-

on-pine-tree traditions"—knitted the titles of two classic carols together, setting up an occasional theme: phrases from "Joy to the World," "The Christmas Song (Chestnuts Roasting on an Open Fire)" and "Away in a Manger" all find their way into the lyric, though they're dropped in as casual conversation rather than obvious puns.

They avoided Santa Claus entirely, and the only mention of gifts wasn't about what might be under the tree; it was a simple recognition that the one gift Mama wanted was for her son to be home.

Appropriately, the bridge ramped up to a highly rhythmic fever, celebrating a sacred Christmas Eve church ceremony while capturing the sense of arrival.

"If you're on that journey, on the way back home, the last mile and a half or two miles, it's the excitement of seeing the people that you love," Kale says. "I think that energy, we unknowingly put into the bridge."

Mosley layered instruments onto the demothat day, and a fair amount of those sounds remained on "Back Home Christmas" all the way through to its release.

"He is some kind of savant," says Rempel. "It's insane."

Meanwhile, High Valley guitarist **Raymond Klassen** whipped up a scenic sonic side trip with an effective Dobro solo. Additionally, a group of around seven musicians gathered in Santa hats to sing an anthemic, **Coldplay**-like signature theme, stacked over a unison mandolin and electric guitar, creating an easy singalong for listeners who share the "Back Home" spirit.

Mosley brought the whole thing to a close with a church bell effect that brightened the ending but also leaves the listener with a complex cluster of notes.

"Any time there's a tubular bell, it's always really hard to make them be perfectly in tune because a tubular bell has like five harmonic notes to it," explains Mosley. "I actually use it a lot in production, but you have to use them in the right spot. It's one of those things where you can't really tune it. Otherwise, it sounds fake."

"Back Home Christmas" sounds quite authentic; it's a fairly universal topic, and Rempel's desire to get back to Canada is real, allowing the song to pass even his holiday-music skepticism. He released it to terrestrial radio through his Cage Free label and Sony Music Canada on Nov. 11 via PlayMPE. And yes, after three years away, Rempel and his family will be back in La Crete for Christmas.

"I was able to book flights for my family just a few weeks ago, and I was able to call my mom and let her know that," Rempel says. "That's definitely, definitely special."

25 Years Ago Michael Peterson Rose To No. 1 'From Here'

In 1997, the singer-songwriter scored the biggest of his three Hot Country Songs top 10s On Dec. 13, 1997, Michael Peterson's "From Here to Eternity" topped *Billboard*'s Hot Country Songs chart. He wrote the ballad with Robert Ellis Orrall, who also co-produced it with Josh Leo.

The track was released as the second offive singles from Peterson's self-titled debut LP, which reached the top 20 on Top Country Albums. "Drink, Swear, Steal & Lie" hit No. 3, becoming his first of three top 10s, and third single "Too Good To Be True" rose to No. 8. "When the Bartender Cries" and "By the Book" hit Nos. 37 and 19, respectively.

Although the Tucson, Ariz., native earned a football scholarship

to Pacific Lutheran University, he simultaneously pursued a career in music. In 1986, he released a Christian album on Sparrow Records. After relocating to Nashville, he signed to Reprise Records in 1996. He transitioned to Monument Records for his 2004 LP Modern Man.

Still actively touring and recording, Peterson, 63, has long supported the United States Armed Forces, performing numerous concerts for deployed service members overseas. In 2008, the USO presented him with the **Bob Hope**-inspired Spirit of Hope Award.
