Country Coda: Eddy Arnold's 'World' Domination >page 16 Readers of a certain age will remember the advent of the year 2000 as one of great mystery, and a small amount of fear.

Computer programs had been designed to use the last two digits of a four-digit year to assess dates, and when the calendar turned from 12-31-99 to 01-01-00, many of those programs were expected to read the last two digits as a reset and crash.

Electric grids might shut down, cold-state citizens might find themselves without heat, streetlights could go dark, and radio and TV stations could conceivably go off the air.

Faith Hill had the No. 1 country single at the time, and its hook — "Just breathe" — was apt advice since none of those potential disasters occurred. Americans still partied like it's 1999.

Kenny Chesney's star was on the rise at the time. "She Thinks My Tractor's Sexy," which remains a staple of his concert setlist, was No. 11 on the Hot Country Songs list dated Jan. 1, 2000, coming less than a year after "How Forever Feels" had spent six

weeks at No. 1. But no one knew what was coming.

In 2003, Chesney headlined a stadium for the first time, drawing more than 61,000 fans to Neyland Stadium in Knoxville, Tenn., as he became a ticket-selling machine. Between his near-constant hit list and 17 No. 1 albums, stadium king Chesney heads the list of Top Country Artists in *Billboard*'s 21st Century Charts. *Billboard* rolled out three 100-position charts May 27-29, with Chris Stapleton's *Traveller* leading Top Country Albums and the Bebe Rexha/Florida Georgia Line

collaboration, "Meant To Be," reigning on Top Hot Country Songs from the start of 2000 through the end of 2024.

Chesney, who is set to be inducted into the Country Music Hall of Fame this fall, scored the pole position among country artists while landing nine titles on the other two lists. Top Country Albums features three Chesney packages: No Shoes, No Shirt,

No Problems; When the Sun Goes Down; and Greatest Hits. Six of his titles appear among the Top Hot Country Songs of the last 25 years: "Don't Blink," "The Good Stuff," "Summertime," "There Goes My Life," "Don't Happen Twice" and "When the Sun Goes Down," the latter recorded with Uncle Kracker.

Longevity matters in the retrospective Artists chart. Five of the top six acts on the list — Chesney, Tim McGraw, Toby Keith, Keith Urban and Rascal Flatts — had hits in the year 2000 and kept making country music through most, if not all, of the last quarter century.

Digital consumption boosted the individual titles on the other two lists. The first six entries among the Top Country Albums were all released after *Billboard* began using streaming data to compile its multimetric lists in 2012. The 17 biggest titles on Top Hot Country Songs, and 19 of the top 20, were all released once streaming data had become a factor. The lone exception in that list's top 20 is Urban's 2002 release "Somebody Like You."

Chesney Is The Top Country Artist On 21st Century Chart

Kenny Chesney rules as the No. 1 country act in *Billboard*'s recap of the first 25 years of the 21st century. He leads *Billboard*'s Top Country Artists of the 21st Century chart — a ranking based on performance on the weekly Top Country Albums and Hot Country Songs charts from the start of 2000 through the end of 2024.

After debuting on *Billboard*'s charts in December 1993 and becoming a format force by 1995, Chesney dominated the first quarter of the 21st century, landing all 17 of his No. 1s on the weekly Top Country Albums chart between 2000 and 2020. With his trademark mix of love songs and breezy beach singalongs, he also ran up 20 No. 1s (of 23 total) on Hot Country Songs in that span. Both totals are the highest among all artists in those years.

Chris Stapleton's *Traveller* Ranks As The Top Country Album On The 21st Century Chart



Chris Stapleton's 2015 LP, *Traveller*, reigns as the No. 1 country album on *Bill-board*'s recap of the first 25 years of the 21st century. The 100-position Top Country Albums of the 21st Century ranking is based on performance on the weekly Top Country Albums chart from the start of 2000 through the end of 2024.

Since debuting in May 2015, *Traveller* has spent a staggering 525 weeks on Top Country Albums (through the chart dated May 31, 2025). Only one other album has rung up 500-plus weeks on the list since its launch in 1964: **Willie Nelson**'s 1978 collection *Stardust* (551).

Traveller hit the Top Country Albums summit on Nov. 21, 2015, and dominated for 29 total weeks. (It also topped the all-genre Billboard 200 for two weeks.) Among its hit songs: perennial streaming favorite "Tennessee Whiskey," which ruled the Hot Country Songs chart for two weeks in 2015, and "Nobody To Blame," Stapleton's first of seven top 10s on Country Airplay.

'Meant To Be': Rexha, Florida Georgia Line Own No. 1 Country Song On 21st Century Chart



Bebe Rexha and Florida Georgia Line's "Meant To Be" dominates as the No. 1 country song on Billboard's recap of the first 25 years of the 21st century. It leads the 100-position Top Hot Country Songs of the 21st Century chart, which reflects performance on the weekly Hot Country Songs chart from the start of 2000 through the end of 2024.

The sunny collaboration by Rexha and FGL—the duo of **Tyler Hubbard** and **Brian Kelley** (which is now on hiatus)—reigns thanks to its 50-week command on Hot Country Songs starting in December 2017. It's the longest No. 1 run since the survey became the genre's singular songs chart in 1958. "Meant To Be" also crossed over to pop and adult radio formats, sparking a top five peak and yearlong stay on the all-genre Billboard Hot 100.



Smith Makes Top 10 'Break'-Through; Wallen's 'Problem' Is 2025's Longest-Leading No. 1

Nate Smith's "Fix What You Didn't Break" (RCA Nashville) rises two spots to No. 9 on *Billboard*'s Country Airplay chart (dated June 7). The single advanced by 6% to 17.1 million audience impress

vanced by 6% to 17.1 million audience impressions May 23-29, according to Luminate.

Smith co-authored the song with Ashley Gorley, Taylor Phillips and Lindsay Rimes, the lattermost of whom also produced it. It's from Smith's album *California Gold*, which arrived at its No. 12 high on Top Country Albums last October.

Smith earns his fourth Country Airplay top 10. It follows "Bulletproof," which hit No. 3 last August. The Paradise, Calif., native's first of four entries, "Whiskey on You," notched two weeks at No. 1 in February 2023, followed by "World on



Fire," which dominated for 10 frames beginning in December 2023. It ties **Morgan Wallen**'s "You Proof" (2022-23) as the longest-leading titles since the chart launched in January 1990.

BIGGER 'PROBLEM' Morgan Wallen's "I'm the Problem" (Mercury/Republic/Big Loud) tops Country Airplay for a seventh total and consecutive week (29.8 million, down 6%).

The third No. 1 and title track from Wallen's new album—which launched atop the Billboard 200 and Top Country Albums (May 31) with 2025's biggest week by equivalent album units (493,000 in the United States)—is the third of his 17 Country Airplay leaders to rule for seven weeks or more, following "You Proof" (as noted above) and "Last Night" (eight weeks, 2023).

"I'm the Problem" solely claims the year's longest No. 1 run on Country Airplay, surpassing the six-week command for **Jelly Roll**'s "Liar" in February-March. Wallen's latest leader and **Shaboozey**'s "A Bar Song (Tipsy)" (seven weeks, August-September 2024) share the longest reigns since **Nate Smith**'s "World on Fire" (also see above).

Meanwhile, Wallen's latest single being promoted to country radio, "Just in Case," lifts 13-11 on Country Airplay (16.1 million, up 9%). ●

Titles that decline in audience but increase in detections will also receive a bullet if the total audience erosion for the week does not exceed 3%.

RECURRENTS

On Country Airplay, descending titles below No. 10 in either audience or detections are moved to recurrent after 20 weeks, provided that they are not still gaining enough audience points to bullet or if they rank below No. 10 and post a third consecutive week of (non-bulleted) audience decline, regardless of total chart weeks. Plus, songs that ascend to a peak between Nos. 1 and 5 will remain on the chart for one additional week even if dropping below No. 10.



60 Years Ago Eddy Arnold Was On Top Of The 'World'

The legendary artist ruled Hot Country Songs, continuing his string of No. 1s dating to 1947

On June 5, 1965, Eddy Arnold topped Billboard's Hot Country Songs chart with "What's He Doing in My World." The hit was co-written by Carl Belew, Eddie Bush and Billy Joe Moore and produced by Chet Atkins.

While the single was Arnold's first of seven No. 1s since the chart had become the genre's singular songs survey in 1958, the iconic crooner had amassed 21 leaders on predecessor *Billboard* country charts in 1947-55. He also banked nine No. 1s on Top Country Albums.

Richard Edward Arnold was born May 15, 1918, into a large farming family in Henderson, Tenn. He was dubbed the "Tennessee Plowboy" early on, influenced by his strong work ethic and country roots. Arnold was attracted to music at a young age, and once his cousin lent him a Sears Silvertone guitar, he was off and running. His mother, **Georgia Wright Arnold**, was also a musician and helped teach her son to play.

Arnold was inducted into the Country Music Hall of Fame in 1966. He died on May 8, 2008. That May 14, a tribute to him was staged at the Ryman Auditorium.
